

# Guide for guests, tourism associations and hosts

## Summer 2022

The "Südtirol Alto Adige Guest Pass/"Holidaypass" is offered to guests (>6 years) on arrival after check-in by the host for the use of public mobility in South Tyrol as a special inclusive service.

### The "Holidaypass":

a) is available to all holiday guests of those accommodation establishments which are members of the local tourist organization (TO), since the pass is funded by membership subscriptions and revenue from TO services; the "Holidaypass" entitles to the use of all public means of transportation belonging to the South Tyrol Integrated Transport Network (all city and extra–urban buses, regional trains, and the following cable cars: Ritten/Renon, Meransen/Maranza, Jenesien/San Genesio, Mölten/Meltina, Vöran/Verano, Kohlern/Colle,

the narrow-gauge railway in Ritten/Renon & the railway up to the Mendel Mountain; only for

the duration of the holiday (not for the arrival!).

Excluded are: Nightliner; Italian InterRegional trains and OEBB, DB, Eurostar or Intercity trains, alpine lines (line 439, 440, 442 & 444); bicycles (7€/day); dogs (single ticket or Mobilcard Junior) and other animals!

- **b)** must be validated on the bus and before each train ride;
- c) is only valid once the name of the guest and their retention time has been entered on the rear side;



- *d)* may NOT be sold;
- e) is valid for up to 7 days after being validated for the first time;

Guests who are staying longer than seven days will receive a second ticket.

- *f*) shall be distributed via the tourist organization according to TO rules;
- g) for premium additional services visit the website/folder of the TO;

### Specifying the geographic area of use

Public buses and regional trains as far as the following borders:

- North: train line 100 as far as Brenner/Brennero
- South: train line 100 as far as Trento
- East: train line 400 as far as Vierschach/Versciaco; on the "Toblach/Dobbiaco-Cortina" route, may be used only buses, which belong to the South Tyrol Integrated Transport Network.
